Syracuse, NY – With the retirement of the sole proprietor of Divine Inspirations, Inc., the Gardening by the Moon lunar almanac, planting guide, and calendar – first published in 1998 – has passed into the care of the worker/owners of Wolf Hill Press, LLC.

Founded in 2022 to publish informative, accurate, beautiful, and Earth-centered works, Wolf Hill Press is comprised of two people, each with years of experience as teachers, publishers, artists, and farmers. Wolf Hill Press is a values-based company, with an extensive ethical policy baked into the LLC's Operating Agreement, and a commitment to support the health and wellbeing of their workers, their neighborhood, their environment, and their customers. These ethics play out at all levels, from using only biodegradable and recycled/recyclable materials in their production process, to creating publications and supplies which not only support an Earth-centric lifestyle, but are financially accessible to a wide range of people.

The world is at a turning point, with many people now realizing they must stop relying on large companies and supplies arriving almost instantly from across the world. People are turning to their own communities, to old ways of growing and storing and sharing seeds, to older and more cyclical ways of keeping time. To support this widening interest in growing food and saving seeds, Wolf Hill Press has added a Central Time version of the almanac as well as an edition designed specifically for the mobile devices of modern farmers.

Wolf Hill Press is proud to publish the most complete and accurate gardening almanac available in the United States. They are committed to preserving the integrity of this valued resource, developed decades ago by artist and gardener Caren Catterall; alongside that commitment, they are excited about the opportunity to deepen the knowledge presented within. Wolf Hill's in-house gardener has consulted numerous scholarly sources, including scientific experiments going back nearly a century, and ancient growing technologies going back to the farming traditions of Europe and North America.

In addition to these steps to improve the accuracy and usability of the lunar almanac, Wolf Hill Press has woven new types of information into the calendar, including solar and lunar eclipses, average frost dates by USDA Hardiness Zone, and lunar planting information specific to seedsaving and the cultivation and harvest of medicinal herbs. The seedsaving information in the calendar is supplemented by seedsaving supplies, such as reusable seed packets and crop- and seed-tracking sheets, each developed over years by Wolf Hill's head gardener for personal use and now available to the public.
